Section 13. (a) In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall have the right to a public trial, by an impartial jury, in the county in which the offense shall have been committed; to be heard by himself and counsel; to demand the nature and cause of the accusation against him, and to have a copy thereof; to meet the witnesses face to face, and to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor.

(b) Victims of crime, as defined by law, shall have the right to be treated with fairness, dignity, and respect throughout the criminal justice process; and, as defined by law, to be informed of and present during public hearings and to confer with the prosecution, to the extent that exercising these rights does not infringe upon the constitutional rights of the accused.

I Shawn OBrien is filing this official complaint against the above mentioned, for PERPETRATORS: or the stated crimes.

Shawn O'Brien, was arrested in Tippecanoe County by a Tippecanoe County Law officer. Shawn O'Brien was in vehicle of Devlon Plunketts, when tippecanoe County law officers stopped the Plunkett vehicle, for tinted windows. Car and Plunkett and O'Brien, was searched without warrants issued by courts of jurisdiction, with probable cause. Carroll County law officers , arrived at scene to assist, for tinted windows.

Shawn O'Brien was taken to Carroll County Jail, and falsely arrested.

Shawn O'Brien filed for suppression of evidence and lack of jurisdiction, and Judge Jeff Smith of superior courts in Delphi Indiana, courts of Carroll County denied, both motions, orally stating that the Carroll County Cops had jurisdiction to arrest O'Brien.

Probable Cause, has not been established, for the arrest of Shawn O'Brien,

Court of Carroll County are very corrupt and do not abide by the Constitution.

Several violation of Shawn O'Briens rights have been violated, and Federal Prosecution of Judge, prosecuting attorney, and public defender, are to be punished according to Law. Plunkett ticket for tinted windows was dismissed.

The Carroll County court system is corrupt and do as they please. Malicious prosecution, and treason, of courts need to stop.
