Judge Donah, does as he pleases in his court room. Constitution is not served, in his court room. Was summons to Tippecanoe Superior Courts on September 19, 2005.

I was in Lafayette, on August 25, 2005 and my truck broke down. I was sitting off a busy highway for about an hour before, two State cops pulled in behind my truck, I had charges pending in Carroll County, and after running my plate, both State cops, were asking me about charges in Carroll county, I was angry, and upset already. I was handcuffed, truck searched, and state police found nothing in truck. I was taken to hospital, for blood test. I refused blood test, and told the nurse and doctor they had to have a warrant, with probable cause affidavit to legally take my blood. After a couple of hours, two big men come in hospital room and held me down, and I was sedated, then blood was drawn from arm.

My sister picked me up, from hospital, and went to pick up purse from my truck that had been towed, forty dollars had been taken from my purse.

I was summons to court September 27, 2005. Plead not guilty, and a deposition hearing scheduled. November 1, 2007, went to court and was told go wait, in hallway until the prosecuting attorney, called my name to go to case management, this is when your made to plead guilty, and make arrangements with prosecutor to enroll in a drug program and put on probation.

I refused case management, reminded courts that I have rights, to have a jury trial, and public defender. They rescheduled, case management for November 19, 2005. Judge Gotham was sitting in for Judge Donah, on November 19 2005 and he allowed me to put

jury trial on dockets, and was appointed a public defender, Phillip Smith.

Every time jury trial was scheduled, Judge Donah vacated it, and lawyers allowed this.

February 8th of 2006, I was represented by Phillip Smith, and was ordered to case management, again I refused, and police, prosecutors and judge donah, was furious, I stood my ground, on jury trial, and told lawyer I wanted to suppress the evidence and file for dismissal, due to untimely filing, Refused case management, and several cops was surrounding me, and was arrested, taken to jail, held without bond for six days. I filed complaints against Judge, prosecutor, and Mister Smith. Smith withdrew from case, after I had filed complaints against, them, and Steve Knecht was appointed. Jury trial vacated by judge, and lawyer allowed this, Public Defender Steve Knecht refused to file for suppression, and dismissal, and withdrew, after, I refused case management. Courts allowing public defenders to withdrawl, without stating why, Mary Russell was appointed, but couldnt take the case, and Public Defender Matt Sandy was appointed. I told him I wanted to go to jury trial, file for suppression, and motion to dismiss. Jury trial, was vacated by judge several times. In January of 2007, was suppose to go to jury trial, Lawyer and Judge Donah vacates, jury trial, and public defender filed for guilty plea, after writing him that I would not take plea, for charges with no evidence, against me. I go to court public defender, response to my turning plea down, " you must like jail" and apologized to the courts. Several jury trials vacated, and on March 22, 2007 case was dismissed by prosecuting attorney.

Have filed claims against courts, public defenders, judge donah, and turned down, by disciplinary committee. Indiana law codes, are in violation of citizens rights, couldnt find law for, illegal dna, and several laws, not published, for fighting corrupt courts.

Constitutional rights have been violated, intimidated by police, Judge Donah, in court room, and falsely arrested.
