I, Susan Sturdivant , am hereby filing this official complaint against the above mentioned perpetrators for the stated crimes,

Judge Julien Ridlan, Magistrate Judge of Cass County, signed a warrant for Susan Sturdivant's residence, in Carroll County in Delphi, Indiana. Warrant was not issued, with an signed affidavit, with probable cause, nor did it describe residence.

Warrant To any City of Logansport, Town of Galveston, Indiana State Police, and Cass County Sheriff . Search Warrant states for all evidence found from search is to be returned to Courts of Logansport, to be disposed of according to law.

Carroll County Sheriffs Department in Delphi, Indiana served warrant. Susan Sturdivant was being held in Cass County Jail without bond, during search. Susan Sturdivant was stopped by Monicello City Police Department on arrest warrant, from Carroll County jail on September 1st, 2004. Was held in County Jail for nine days, on three felonies, and one misdemeanor. Search Warrant stated for evidence to be returned to Cass County where Sturdivant, was arrested. Bonded out of jail nine days after arrested, through a bondsman. Seven days after bonded from Carroll County Jail, bond was void, not knowing this for about 8 months afterwards. Hired Marcel Katz for an attorney, and he failed to file for lack of jurisdiction, motions to dismiss , and to suppress evidence. Katz withdrew from case. Courts appointed, three public defenders.

Public Defenders , would not file for lack of jurisdiction, suppression or motion to dismiss, and all withdrew from case. Public defenders did not file an Appearance to the courts, and quit the case, because they was more for the courts then client.

Filed for new judge, representing my self , judge granted motion, and we striked out two judges, and Judge from Cass County Judge Maughmer, declined to take the case, and months later, phoned the clerk, and she said that no one would take the case, Sturdivant

received, a court order , revoking motion for new judge. I filed complaint on judge, and he supposedly retired, but last I knew he is still, part time. Judge Donald Currie, took over in Carroll Circuit Courts, filed for suppression and overlooked, public defenders appointed, without request, or decision of defendant. Public Defenders, worked with courts and was pushing a B felony, drug charge. After a couple of motions to dismiss, Lack of jurisdiction, motions denied by Judge Currie. Suppression was held and represented myself, and won on falsified evidence of police and prosecutors.

Evidence was fabricated, and James Klepinger, of Logansport City Police, along with prosecutor Robert Ives falsified, an affidavit for my residence, was marked as exhibit, for evidence during suppression. Voided bond was ordered released, and bondsman Linda Farner, kept bond. Paperwork for voided bond was accidentally given to defendant. Questioned voided bond several times. Public record of bond was tampered with, full page marked void several times, was replaced by a half a sheet of paper, with words, typed on top, void if pink censor box is hot.. Writing didnt match papers I had, Filed claim, and denied Judge Currie sent, statement saying that fines and jailed, if filed anything else, against courts. Paperwork filed from clerks office is not in public file Carroll County Deputies, come to Residence on I believe August 4th 2006 with bench warrant for my son, and forced themselves in my home. Searched home and Sturdivant was arrested and taken to jail. The next morning charges dropped, released from jail, went home, and paperwork was missing from residence, police officers , was in home a couple of hours after I was taken to jail.

Void bond, seven days after bonding from jail, Robert Ives , and Judge Currie, still prosecuted case for 18 months after bond was void, Paper work on bond receipt states, sheriff signed for surety, and stamped the next day at clerks office. Bond was not returned and told that bondman Linda Farner, kept the money.

Filed to both judges of Carroll County misconduct of courts, and prosecutors for not serving by the Constitution. Paperwork denied, and overlooked. To this day many including my son, is being detained, without due process of law being served. Probation

uses swab test and by federal codes, swab testing is not admissible. The courts have torn many families and every day people illegal detained, without warrants, or the Constitution being served. Misconduct of courts, judges and prosecutors, need to be punished according to law, Public defenders, need to be disbarred, and justice needs to be served in Carroll County Courts, in Delphi Indiana 46923
